1. Situation To publish instructions for the nominations of meritorious promotions within 2d Marine Aircraft Wing (2d MAW). Meritorious promotion authority for Private First Class (PFC), Lance Corporal (LCpl), Corporal (Cpl) and Sergeant (Sgt) is delegated to the Commanding General (CG), 2d MAW. The Commanding Officer (CO), Marine Wing Headquarters Squadron 2 (MWHS-2) and each Group within 2d MAW will select exceptionally well-qualified Marines who have demonstrated outstanding leadership and performance to compete at the Wing Board.

2. Cancellation. WgO 1400.2A.

3. Mission. The 2d MAW Meritorious Promotion Board will convene to select the Meritorious PFC, LCpl, Cpl and Sgt allocation retained at Wing level. The allocations for meritorious promotion to PFC, LCpl, Cpl and Sgt for each Group and MWHS-2 will be announced via separate correspondence.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations.

Meritorious promotions are designed to recognize outstanding leadership. Marines recommended for meritorious promotion must have demonstrated outstanding leadership to a degree rarely attained by Marines of equal grade.

(1) Staff Non Commissioned Officer (SNCO) Meritorious Promotion Board

(a) Reference (a) provides policy and guidance to the CG, 2d MAW to nominate one exceptional Staff Sergeant (SSgt) and two Sgt's for meritorious promotion to the next higher grade.

(b) The 2d MAW SNCO Meritorious Promotion Board will convene annually and it will consist of the following members: 2d MAW Sergeant Major (SgtMaj) (Senior Member of the Board), 2d MAW Group SgtsMaj and MWHS-2 SgtMaj. Each Group and MWHS-2 will have a Master Sergeant (MSgt) or Master Gunnery Sergeant (MGySgt) as Board Members.

(c) Once nominations are made by the 2d MAW SNCO Meritorious Promotion Board, and with the concurrence of the CG, 2d MAW, the nominations will be forwarded to the CG, II Marine Expeditionary Force (II MEF), as the 2d MAW SNCO Meritorious Promotion nominees.

(d) If selected by the II MEF Meritorious Promotion Board, and concurred with by the CG, II MEF, the nominations will be forwarded via naval message to the Commandant of the Marine Corps via Marine Corps Forces Command (MARFORCOM) for final approval.

(e) Eligibility

1. Marines recommended for meritorious promotion must have demonstrated outstanding leadership to a degree rarely attained by Marines of equal grade. A nominee must possess the degree of leadership appropriate to the next higher grade and demonstrate a capacity to discharge the duties and responsibilities associated with the grade for which they are recommended.

2. A nominee must have served a minimum of six years time in service for promotion to Gunnery Sergeant (GySgt)

(not waiverable).

3. A nominee must have served a minimum of four years time in service for promotion to SSgt (not waiverable).

4. Time in grade is not applicable for meritorious promotions.

5. Per reference (b), Professional Military Education (PME) requirements for all SNCO selection boards and meritorious promotions are in effect. Commanders will consider PME as one of the many factors in a Marine's record to determine the best qualified for meritorious promotion.

6. Marines already selected for advancement through normal promotion board selections, but not yet promoted, are not eligible for meritorious promotion consideration.

7. Recommendations for meritorious promotion should not be made solely as a reward for "faithful service" of where a personal award recommendation would be more appropriate.

8. All training will be current. Non Resident PME will be complete.

(2) Meritorious Promotion to PFC, LCpl, Cpl and Sgt

(a) Reference (c) established policy that authorizes CGs to award meritorious promotions to active duty Marines in the grade of Private (Pvt) through Sgt in numbers that do not exceed quarterly allocations. Reference (c) also provides policy and instructions for effecting special promotions, computing the quota allocations.

(b) Eligibility

1. Demonstrated superior performance-military record.

2. Ability to satisfactorily discharge the responsibilities of the next higher grade.

3. Minimum requirements for time in grade can be waived.

4. Time in service requirement must be met.

(c) Unit Recommendation Guidelines. COs should use the following guidelines for evaluating a Marine's qualification for consideration:

1. Sustained exemplary performance of duty clearly meriting promotion over other qualified Marines.

2. Demonstrated leadership abilities and potential to assume increased responsibility.

3. Exemplary physical fitness and personal appearance.

b. Tasks

(1) AC/S, G-1

(a) Compute and provide Wing SgtMaj with distribution break-out of quotas.

(b) Release Naval Message announcing allocations to the Groups and MWHS-2 by the first working day of each quarter (Apr, Jul, Oct, Jan).

5. Administration and Logistics

a. Required Documentation

(1) GySgt/SSgt Meritorious Promotion Board. All nominations will be prepared in accordance with reference (a).

(2) PFC, LCpl, Cpl and Sgt Promotion Board (if needed)

(a) Squadron Commander's recommendation letter with endorsement from Group CO.

(b) Record Book Data Sheet (enclosure (2)).

(c) Marine Corps Total Force System (MCTFS) screens: TBIR/TBTR, TEDU and AWDS.

(3) Results of quotas assigned to each Group on MWHS-2 require a record book data sheet (enclosure (2)) be submitted with the names of those to be promoted to the Wing SgtMaj.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to all units assigned or attached to 2d MAW.

b. Signal. This Order is effective the date signed.
