1. Situation. This Order represents the initiating directive for the Command Inspector General (CIG) Professional Development and Credential Program.

2. Cancellation. WgO 5430.1.

3. Mission. To establish the policy and procedures to certify and credential CIG personnel who perform investigative functions.

4. Execution

a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

(1) Commander's Intent. This Order will be utilized by the CIG to certify investigative personnel and issue CIG Credentials to certified CIG personnel who perform inspection and investigative functions. All CIG personnel will be informed of the contents of this Order.

(2) Concept of Operations

(a) All newly assigned CIG personnel will attend a service level Inspector General (IG) School in order to satisfy basic competency and understanding of IG philosophy, procedures and policy.

DISTRIBUTION STATEMENT A: Approved for public release; distribution is unlimited.

(b) All CIG personnel who perform investigative functions will complete annual proficiency requirements established by the Secretary of the Navy and Inspector General of the Marine Corps (IGMC).

(c) All CIG personnel who meet the standards listed in this paragraph will be issued CIG Credentials.

b. Subordinate Element Missions

(1) Command Inspector General

(a) Ensure CIG personnel are certified per the references.

(b) Maintain a log of all CIG personnel certifications.

(c) Issue serialized CIG credentials to certified CIG personnel. Utilize enclosure (1) as a template for credentials.

(d) Retrieve CIG credentials from personnel who no longer qualify for CIG credentials.

(e) Maintain a log of all CIG credentials issued and retrieved.

(2) Command Inspector General Personnel

(a) Ensure they are familiar with this Order and its references.

(b) Use CIG credentials only as authorized.

(c) Immediately report lost or missing CIG Credentials.

(d) Surrender CIG Credentials when directed by the Commander or CIG.

5. Administration and Logistics. All CIG personnel issued CIG Credentials shall comply with the references in the execution of their duties.

6. Command and Signal

a. Command. This Order is applicable to all uniformed and civilian members of the CIG.

b. Signal. This Order is effective the date signed.
