Is the Marine Ready for the Mission?

- Flight events
- Liberty/Leave
- PT
- Maintenance

Is the Equipment ready for the Marine?

- Aircraft
- POV
- Tools
- PT/recreation/sports

Is the Mission necessary?

- There's no mission in training that's worth compromising the safety of our Marines

Have a plan and be accountable to yourself and your squadron mates.
