Commander's Significant Notification Events

Wake up the CO - Immediate Notification

- #1: Any fatality or serious injury to any Warrior Marine or Sailor.
- > #2: Any loss, damage, or injury that could result in a Class A-E Aviation or Ground Mishap.
- > #3: Any threat to Warrior assets, resources, Marines, Sailors, or their families.
- #4: Any concern over the physical, emotional, or mental wellbeing of any Warrior or dependent.
- > #5: Any event that requires an official report to leave the squadron (e.g. Flash report, OPREP-3 Serious Incident Report (SIR), Personnel Casualty Report (PCR), etc).
- > #6: Any aircraft landing at a location other than intended destination. (e.g. PEL)
- > #7: Any Warrior aircraft overdue by more than 15 minutes without approval or communication.
- > #8: Any high-profile event involving Warriors that could result in media interest and/or could call into question the professionalism of HMLA-167.
- > #9: Any compromise of classified material, information, or EKMS equipment.

Notify the CO at earliest convenience

- Any assigned FRAG goes unsupported for any reason.
- AH-1Z or UH-1Y Mission Capable (MC) rate drops below 50%.
